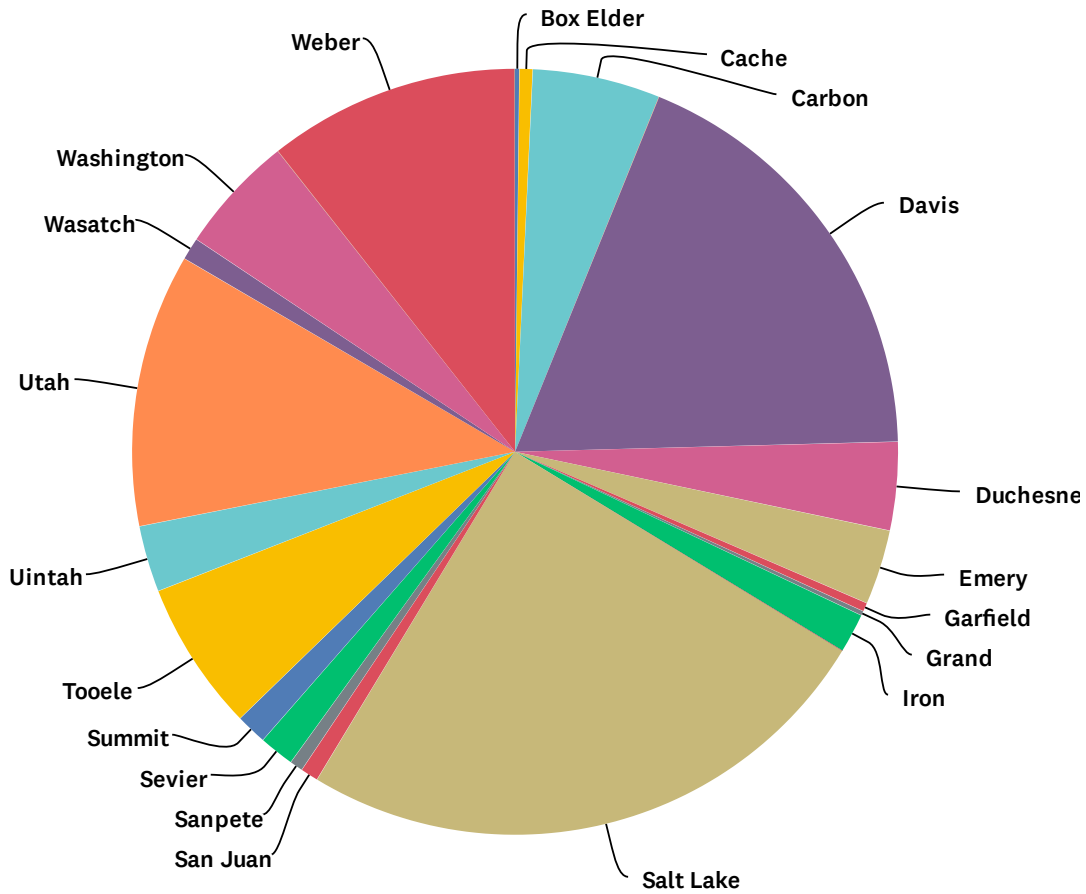


Q1 What county do you live in?

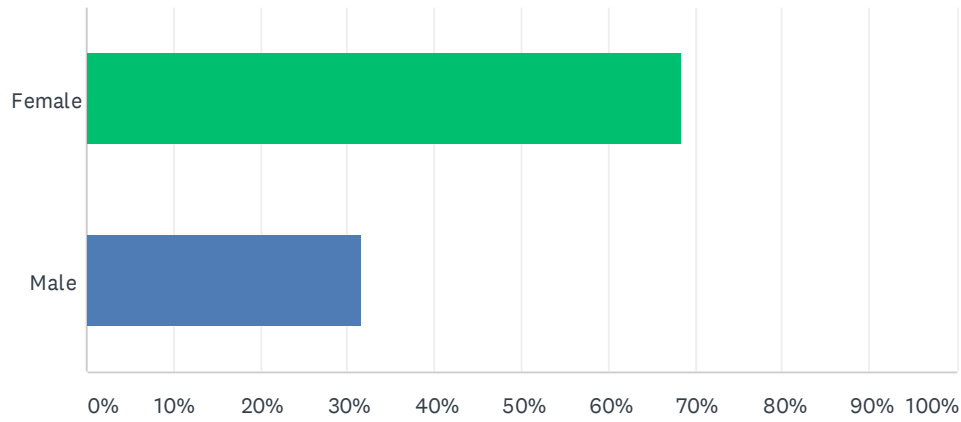

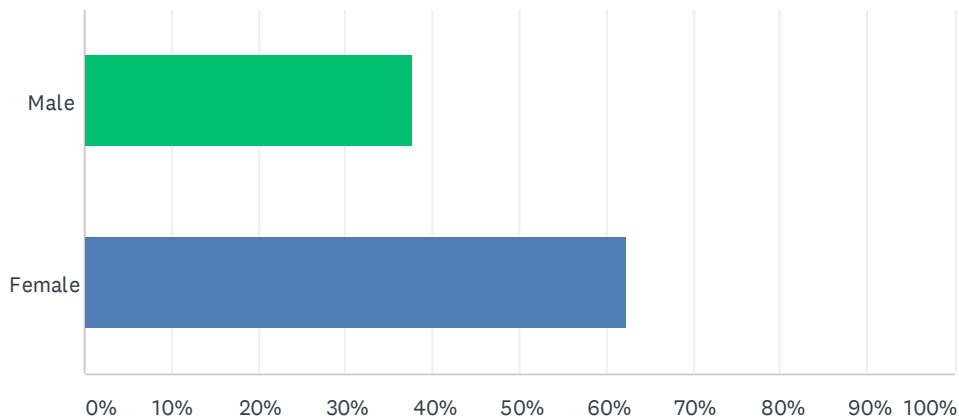

Q3 What is the gender of the person you care for?

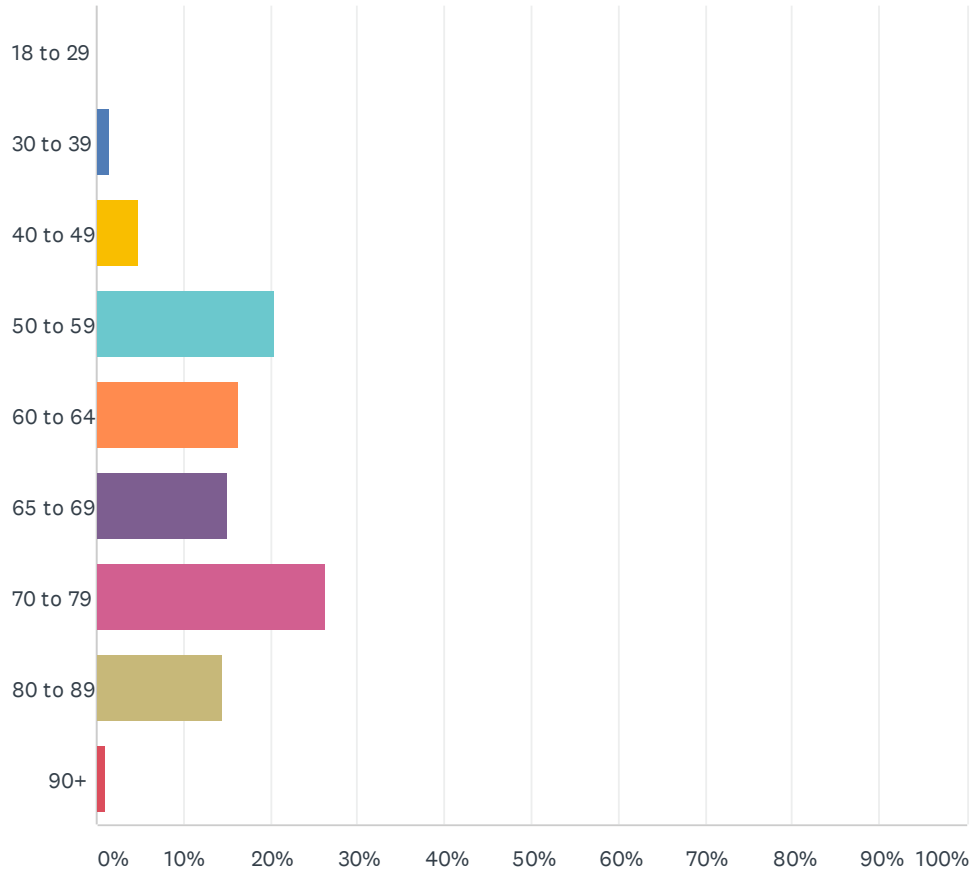

Q4 What is your age?

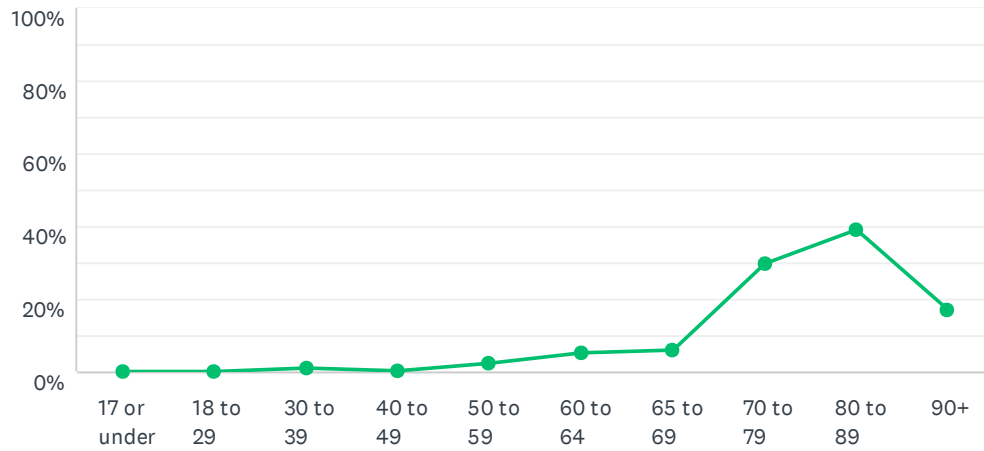

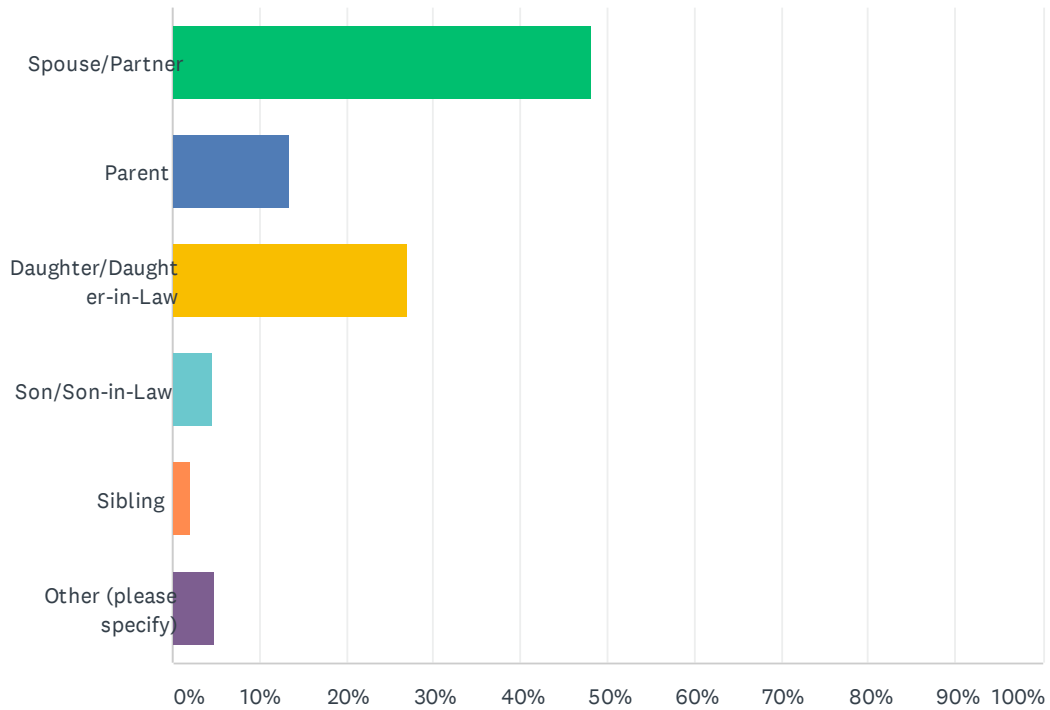

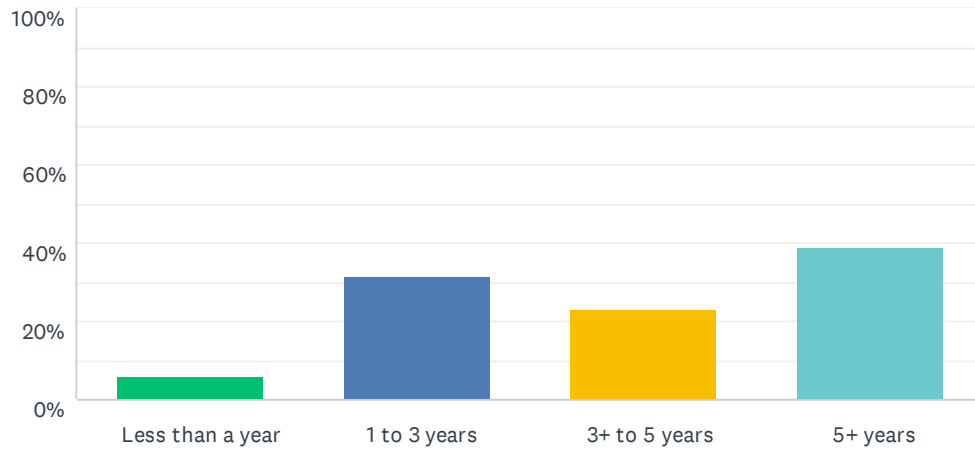

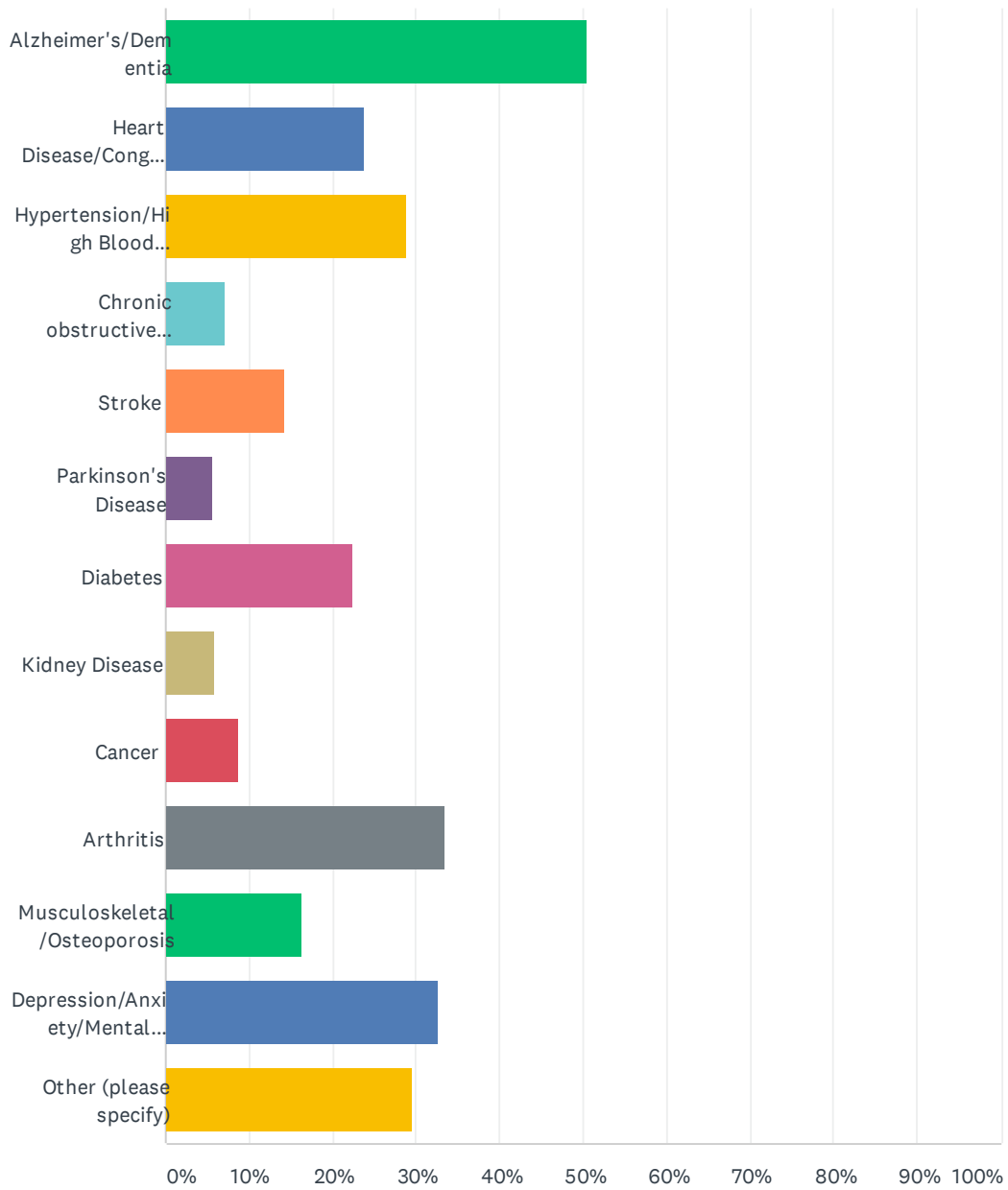

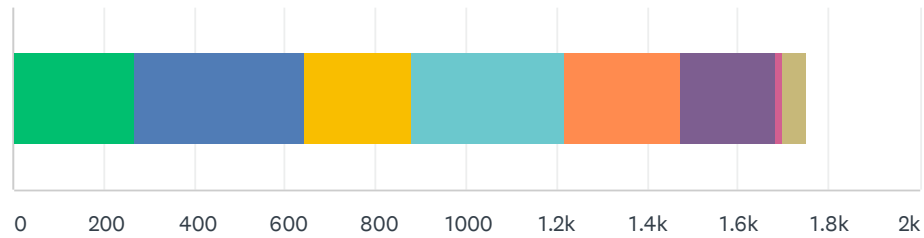
