

Free Legal Services For Veterans with Housing Concerns

Utah Legal Services, under the time-limited LSV-H Grant (ending June 2027), has established free legal support for qualified veterans who have housing concerns. Eligibility requirements include having any discharge status other than dishonorable, and active-duty service for at least 24 months. (An individual is considered homeless if they have no full-time residence, and is considered on the verge of homelessness if they are at risk of losing their current stable housing.)
