

In Memoriam: Cheryl Connors



Cheryl Horsley Connors (1944 – 2022), a registered dietitian and longtime member of WCOFE (Weber County Organization for the Elderly), supported meal services in senior centers and meals-on-wheels in Weber and Morgan Counties, writing menus for over 40 years.

She was born in 1944, graduated from Ogden High School, and completed her education as a dietitian at the University of Utah. After

internship at Peter Brent Bingham Hospital in Boston, she worked at the old Dee Hospital and McKay-Dee Hospital. She later started her own dietetics consulting business for nursing facilities, and worked for Weber Human Services.

Cheryl volunteered as a board member of WCOFE and contributed her expertise to activities, education, and nutrition services in senior centers. Her influence on Aging Services may be described as “holistic Aging,” enhancing others academically as a dietitian as well as culturally through activities such as quilting and pickle-ball. In many ways, she was a great influencer for the well-being of others.
